GENERAL DUTY STATEMENT:

Performs full-performance inspections to ensure that sheet metal installations involving heating and ventilation are done according to approved plans and specifications and in accordance with pertinent portions of the Minnesota State Building Code. Inspects and reports on installations and alterations of sheet metal work to assure that approved materials are used and proper workmanship is performed. Orders and enforces corrections on items that are not in compliance. Witnesses tests of mechanical installations, equipment, and materials. Interprets code to fit both typical and unusual situations. Performs other related duties and responsibilities as required.

Essential Functions are the functions that the individual holding the position must be able to perform unaided or with the assistance of a reasonable accommodation. The Essential Functions for this position are identified in the Supplemental Information section of the <u>Sheet Metal Inspector Job Description</u>.

REQUIREMENTS:

High School or Vocational School Diploma and possession of an official certificate evidencing the completion of an apprenticeship as a sheet metal worker, such as is issued by the State of Minnesota, and five years of experience as a journey-level sheet metal worker.

Or, a High School or Vocational School Diploma and eleven years of experience in sheet metal work, at least seven years of which must have been as a journey-level sheet metal worker.

Candidates must possess a Certificate of Competency issued by the City of Saint Paul or the City of Minneapolis as a journey-or master-level warm air and ventilation worker.

Candidates must possess and maintain a valid Minnesota Class D Driver's License, or equivalent out-of-state driver's license. The driver's license must have no suspensions or revocations for driving-related offenses within the two year period prior to the date of appointment. Suspensions for parking-related offenses are excluded.
